

LIABILITY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS

Please review this information carefully as exhibitors may not set up and exhibit without proof of insurance. If you have any questions, please contact amcexhibitorcare@tradeshowlogic.com.

- All exhibitors must provide a Certificate of Insurance to the Meat Institute. Coverage requirements are below and certificates must be <u>uploaded to the Exhibitor Dashboard</u> by **February 26.**
- The Gaylord Opryland requires a certificate of insurance from all exhibitors. Review their requirements below and submit the certificate <u>directly to them</u> by **February 19.** Don't forget to also submit the required <u>food sampling forms</u>!
- Exhibitors using an Exhibitor Appointed Contractor to set-up/dismantle their space (other than GES, the official contractor) must have their EAC <u>submit a COI</u> to GES by **February 19.**

Exhibitor and Exhibitor Appointed Contractor Insurance Coverage Requirements

All Exhibitors are required to carry insurance that adequately covers the Exhibitor and its property from theft, public liability, product liability, property damage, personal injury, and other loss or liability that may be incurred at or in connection with the Annual Meat Conference.

Exhibitor shall purchase commercial general liability insurance, placed with a financially stable insurance carrier, which insures Exhibitor's operations and obligations under this agreement. Said policy shall have limits of no less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence. The foregoing insurance is a minimum requirement and shall in no way limit the liability of the Exhibitor.

Additionally, an Exhibitor utilizing an Exhibitor Appointed Contractor (EAC) for set-up/dismantle of booth space must have the EAC provide evidence of insurance (certificate of insurance) in the amount of no less than \$2,000,000 in general liability coverage.

You may purchase insurance through <u>Rainprotection</u>, the official insurance supplier for the Annual Meat Conference, if you do not have your own, or would rather not use your own insurance.

Gaylord Opryland Insurance Coverage Requirements

The Gaylord Opryland also requires a certificate of insurance with the following details.

Vendor shall carry comprehensive general liability insurance including products liability and contractual liability for bodily injury or property damage with a combined single limit of not less than \$1,000,000 (\$1 Million) each occurrence. Vendor shall provide the Hotel with a certificate of insurance evidencing such coverage and naming the Hotel Manager and the Hotel owner as additional insured prior to the food tradeshow.
